Student SMART ID Card (debit card) Issuing Process



Prepare your SCB savings account

- If you have already had an SCB savings account, you can use your existing account. If you want to open a new account, please contact any SCB branch nationwide, or open an online savings account (no passbook) via the SCB EASY App.
- If you never have an SCB savings account, please contact any SCB branch nationwide, or open an online savings account (no passbook) via the following channels:
 - Open an account by validating your identity 7-Eleven
 - Open an account by validating your identity at SCB ATMs
 - Open an account by validating your identity using the NDID feature via other mobile banking apps



STEP 1

Notes : Opening an account at SCB branch will require a minimum deposit of 500 baht. (Opening an account with a zero balance will require the university's referral letter to allow the "zero-balance account" condition permitted only one account per customer).

STEP 2

Connect your account

Go to "Settings" > "Manage Accounts" > Choose the required account to connect and display on the SCB EASY App.

Card Application via the SCB EASY App

- Request your Student SMART ID Card (debit card) via the SCB EASY App during the availability period only. (The card application feature will be terminated after the above period. Please contact the university for card issuance)

STEP 3



Apply for the Direct Debit via the SCB EASY App

By following these easy steps

1. Go to the "Apply direct debit" menu.
2. Choose the account linked to your student ID debit card for direct debit service.
3. Choose the "Billers" by looking for your university name or logo, or enter the biller name in the "Search" box. Enter your student ID number as Ref 1 and leave Ref 2 blank.



Get your card, activate it, and set your PIN

- Your card will be sent to the address provided in Step 3 within 7 working days.
- Upon receiving your debit card, activate it and set your PIN.
